The Sir Edward Howard Marsh Literary File Photography Collection consists of 79 photographs, including portraits of Marsh alone and with other notable people, such as Winston Churchill. There are also portraits of Gordon Bottomley, Rupert Brooke, and Ivor Novello, as well as scenes of various places in and peoples of East Africa.
